Mr. Kalin introduced himself and Ms. Steinerts to the Board Members and advised that he was filling in for his associate, Mr. Silva. Ms. Steinerts indicated that she was covering today's meeting for her associate, Ginger Wald.

A. CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Kalin called the May 17, 2018, Regular Board Meeting of the Meadow Pines Community Development District to order at 9:32 a.m. in the Cobblestone Clubhouse located at 14701 SW 10th Street, Pembroke Pines, Florida 33027.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Proof of publication was presented which showed that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Sun Sentinel* on September 29, 2017, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Kalin determined that the attendance of Chairman Douglas Harrison, Vice Chairperson Jennifer Marmanillo and Supervisor Leon Brown constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

Also in attendance were: District Manager Neil Kalin of Special District Services, Inc.; and General Counsel Vanessa Steinerts of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A.

D. CONSIDER BOARD MEMBER RESIGNATION

Mr. Kalin stated that he was in possession of a resignation letter from Ms. Xiony Lima and that it would be in order to officially accept her resignation with an effective date of February 23, 2018. A brief discussion ensued after which, the following motion was made:

A **motion** was made by Mr. Harrison, seconded by Mr. Brown and unanimously passed to *accept* the resignation of Xiony Lima with an effective date of February 23, 2018.

E. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA

Mr. Kalin indicated that since there had been changes on the Board of Supervisors, it would be in order to re-elect the Officers of the Board. His request was acknowledged and the following slate of officers was presented for election:

- Chairperson Douglas Harrison
- Vice Chairperson Leon Brown
- Secretary/Treasurer Armando Silva

• Assistant Secretaries – Jennifer Marmanillo

A **motion** was made by Mr. Harrison, seconded by Mr. Brown and unanimously passed to elect the officers of the Board of Supervisors of the District, as listed above.

F. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

G. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. January 18, 2018, Regular Board Meeting

Mr. Kalin presented the minutes of the January 18, 2018, Regular Board Meeting and asked if there were any corrections and/or revisions. There being none, a **motion** was made by Mr. Harrison, seconded by Mr. Brown and passed unanimously approving the minutes of the January 18, 2018, Regular Board Meeting, as presented.

H. OLD BUSINESS

It was noted, for the record, that Mr. Rafael Stocki, a resident of the community/District, was not in attendance, nor had he contacted any of the Board Members regarding any business matters of the District.

I. NEW BUSINESS

1. Discussion Regarding the Upkeep of District Improvements – Wetland Mitigation Area Perimeter Wooden Fence

Mr. Kalin confirmed that the District owns and maintains the wooden fence located at the perimeter of the Wetland Mitigation Area within the District. A discussion ensued after which the Board gave direction to have District Staff receive proposals/quotes for fixing deteriorated panels on the perimeter fence and also obtain proposals/quotes for replacing the entire perimeter wooden fence.

2. Discussion Regarding Snake Encounter – Prevention Informational Pamphlet

The Board was provided with a detailed summary and informational pamphlet regarding dealing with a snake encounter. A discussion ensued after which the Board consensus was to have the "Snake Encounter" pamphlet sent to the HOA Manager so that it could be sent to all residents via an "email blast". Mr. Kalin will discuss this item with Mr. Silva to be sure the finished pamphlet is provided to HOA management.

3. Consider Resolution No. 201-02 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Proposed Budget

Mr. Kalin presented Resolution No. 2018-02, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE MEADOW PINES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET AND NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Kalin read the title of the resolution into the record and indicated that the proposed 2018/2019 fiscal year budget had been balanced by designating a carryover of approximately \$12,500 from the projected fund balance as of September 30, 2018. Mr. Kalin advised that since the overall proposed assessments were not increasing in the fiscal year 2018/2019, letters to residents would not be required. Furthermore, he stated as part of Resolution No. 2018-02, the Board must set a date for the public hearing to adopt the fiscal year 2018/2019 final budget and assessments. Additional discussion took place on the proposed budget after which;

A **motion** was made by Mr. Harrison, seconded by Ms. Marmanillo and unanimously passed approving and adopting Resolution No. 2018-02, *as presented*, setting the public hearing to adopt the fiscal year 2018/2019 final budget and assessments for July 17, 2018, at 9:30 a.m. in the Cobblestone Clubhouse Meeting Room located at 14701 SW 10th Street, Pembroke Pines, Florida 33027; and further authorizing publication/notice of the budget public hearing, as required by law.

Prior to leaving this item, Ms. Marmanillo requested information on the street lights adjacent to the District and run along Pembroke Road. Mr. Kalin advised that he would discuss the referenced lighting with Mr. Silva and report on any findings at the next meeting.

4. Consider Resolution No. 2018-03 – Adopting a Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement

Resolution No. 2018-03 was presented, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE MEADOW PINES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, STATE OF FLORIDA, APPROVING THE *REVISED* FLORIDA STATEWIDE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Kalin explained the purpose for considering the revised document. A discussion ensued after which;

A **motion** was made by Mr. Harrison, seconded by Mr. Brown and unanimously passed accepting and approving Resolution No. 2018-03, *as presented*, authorizing District officials to execute the Mutual Aid Agreement, as required.

J. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

1. Statement of Financial Interests – 2017 Form 1

Mr. Kalin advised the Board Members that their individual 2017 Form 1, Financial Disclosure Form, should be received in the mail before the end of May. The deadline for submittal to the Supervisor of Elections' Office within the County of residency is July 2, 2018.

2. Discussion Regarding Vacancy in Seat Nos. 4 & 5

Mr. Kalin recommended, due to the vacancies on the Board of Supervisors, that the current Board consider holding the June meeting in an attempt to bring forth interested residents that would serve on the Board of Supervisors. The Board was open to the recommendation and will contact the District Manager, should there be any qualified person(s) that would serve on the Board. No further action was taken in this matter at this time.

3. Announcement of Candidate Qualifying Period

Mr. Kalin advised that the candidate qualifying period to run for the District election on the general election ballot would be from noon on June 18, 2018, through noon on June 22, 2018. Terms of office are expiring in Seats #1, 3 & 5.

K. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

It was noted, depending on the success of finding interested qualified residents to serve on the District's Board of Supervisors, that the next meeting would be held on June 21, 2018.

L. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion was made by Mr. Harrison, secon	nded

At the October 15, 2015 Meadow Pines Community Development District Board Of Supervisors meeting, the firm of Grau & Associates was selected to perform the 9-30-2015, 9-30-2016 and 9-30-2017 year end audits of the District with an option to perform the 9-30-2018 and 9-30-2019 audit.
